

Key Vocabulary: History

Allies – countries that fought on the same side Evacuee – someone who was evacuated from danger to a safer place (normally from cities to a more rural place)

Rationing – the controlled distribution of scarce resources (mainly food and clothes)

Air raid shelter — a building to protect people from bombs dropped from planes.

Trenches – a long, narrow ditch used by troops to shelter from enemy fire or attack.

Nazi – member of the fascist German political party which came to power in 1933.

Blitz — series of aerial bombing raids on the UK, mainly cities including London, Bristol and Nottingham.


Luftwaffe — The German air force.

Key Event in History Date **Key events** September 1, 1939 Germany invades Poland 1 2 September 3, 1939 Britain and France declare war on Germany (start of WW2) 3 January, 1940 Rationing introduced across the UK Dunkirk evacuated and France surrenders to Germany 4 May to June, 1940 Germany uses blitzkrieg to take over much of Western Europe Germany launches air attacks on Great Britain (The Battle of Britain and the Blitz begins) 5 July, 1940 Germany, Italy and Japan signed the Tripartite Pact creating the axis alliance The Japanese attack the US navy in Pearl Harbor. The next day, the 6 December 7, 1941 USA enters the war fighting with the allies D-day and the Normandy invasion. Allied forces invade France and 7 June 6, 1944 push back the Germans 8 April 30, 1945 Adolf Hitler commits suicide 9 Germany surrenders & victory in Europe is declared the next day May 7, 1945 Atomic bombs dropped on Hiroshima & Nagasaki, Japan by the US 10 August 1945 killing approximately 226,000 people 11 September 2, 1945 Japan surrenders signaling the end of WW2 12 July, 1954 Rationing ends in the UK




