Specific Areas



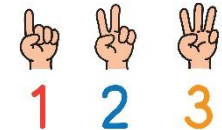
Literacy

- Revision of all phase 2 and phase 3 graphemes
- Read longer words, compound words and words ending with in, ed (t), ed (id) ed (est), ed (d), er, est, s (z), es.
- Develop our blending of sounds into words using diagraphs and trigraphs, to read longer words.
- Continue to develop our blending skills in the books we share to read longer sentences, including reading tricky words.
- Revisit tricky words: is, as, the, I, put, pull, full, and, push, into, no, go, to, his, has, of, she, he, we, me, was, you, they, my, by, all, are, pure, sure
- Learn new tricky words: said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today.
- Practice our spelling.

Naming and making observations of animals, similarities and differences, why things happen, changes, contrasting environments,



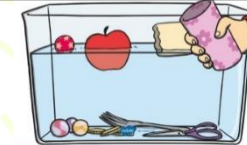
