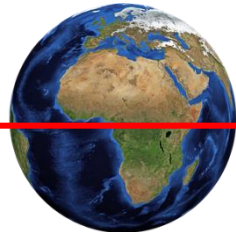

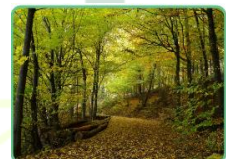
Amazon Rainforest

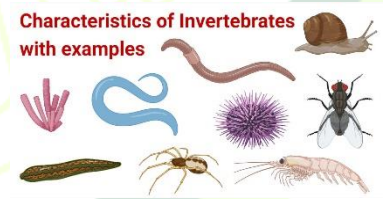

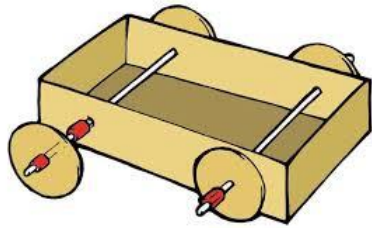

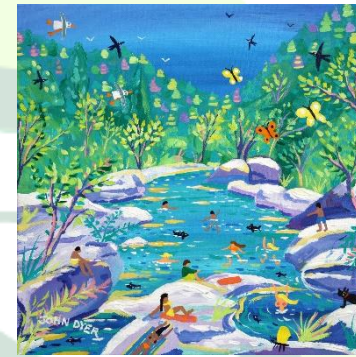
