Homework

My Maths will also be set most Thursdays. We would encourage children to do their Times Table Rockstars every day for 3 or 4 minutes.

Sometimes we will set alternative homework related to topic.

We award house points and table points in class for good learning and excellent behaviour.

Children will earn shells for good behaviour around the school.

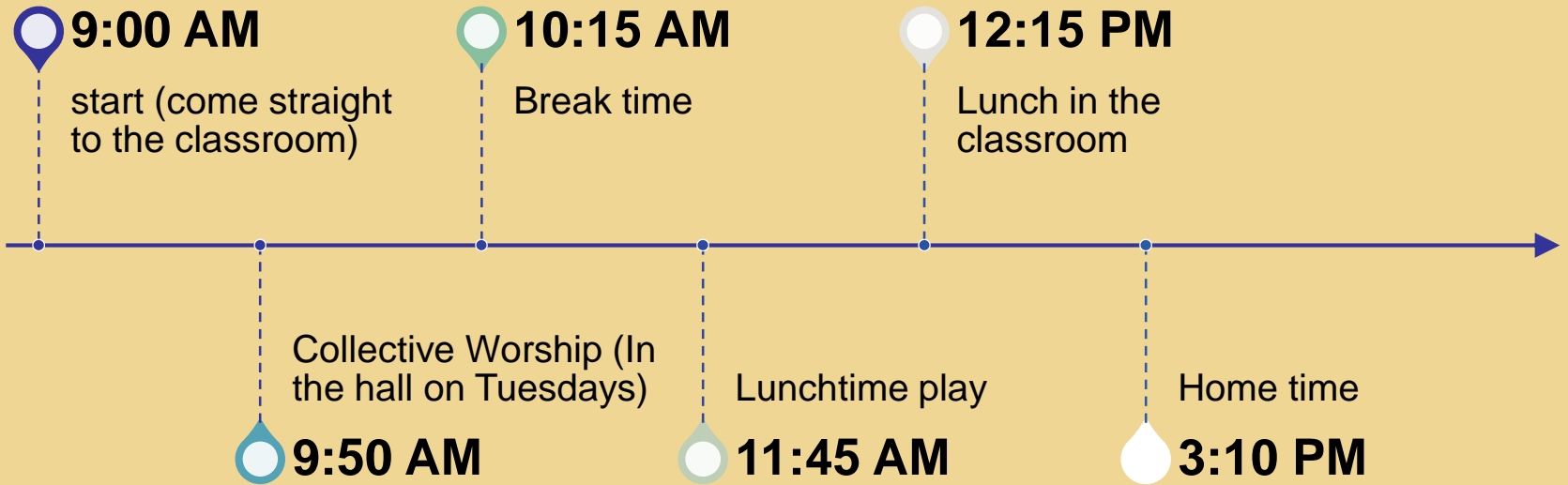
General Reminders
