Dear Year 1,

Please look at the Home Learning Grid for more detail on today's activities.

<u>English focus</u>: Book characters. Recap on what a 'character' is. Talk about characters from some of your favourite books. What makes them so much fun to read about? Do they appear in a series of books? Do your brothers and sisters like reading about them too? Make a collage or picture of one of your favourite characters.

<u>English key questions</u>: Can an animal be a character in a book? What is your favourite character? Are the like you? Are they different to you?

Phonics focus: revision of all sounds learnt this term.

Use phonics play or some of the practical ideas and games from earlier on in the term to recap the sounds we have learnt.

Maths focus: Problem solving. Read the problem through first and talk about strategies to help you. Look at the 'Squashed fruit' problem in the 'Maths activity sheets WB 13.7.20. Use the grid to cross off the children's names as they solve the clues. You do not need to print off a copy of the clues for each child, you could work through them together displaying the clues on the computer. This will need to be done with a parent.

Maths key questions: What calculations do you need to do to help you?

Then choose one other activity from the Home Learning Grid.
