

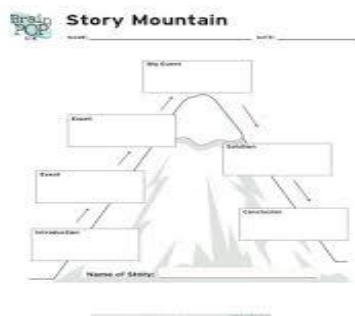
Dear Year 6,

Happy Tuesday to you all!

Thank you for all the wonderful work that has been sent in from yesterday. What a lot of talented artists we have at St James'. All the character descriptions were incredibly different, and the details added made sure that the character has depth – hopefully leading to an exciting story in the days ahead.

Today we would like you to have a look at the second column of the learning grid. It asks you to complete the following Maths and English Tasks:

1. **English (1 hour):** Create a simple story mountain using a pencil and ruler. Label the opening, build-up, problem, resolution and ending. Under each section, use bullet points to note down your ideas for your adventure story – try to make it exciting and dramatic. Will there be a curse or a magic amulet? Will the main character be captured by a malevolent character trying to steal the pharaoh's treasure? How can you engage the reader effectively in your narrative? Once you have a plan for the story, start on your opening. Remember that your brilliant description needs to set the scene and 'hook' the reader in...



2. **Maths (1 hour):** Please complete pages 22, 23 & 24. Make sure to check your answers once finished and ask an adult for help with your corrections. MyMaths is a good resource to remind you of the methods needed and if you have any questions, please feel free to email your class teacher.

In the afternoon, we would like you to choose from the following activities (check the learning grid for more detail):

1. **Topic:** Create a cardboard model of an Egyptian barge along with an information card explaining why these boats were buried in the tombs of the Egyptians or create a booklet with details of Egyptian jobs.
2. **Science:** Create a habitat or bug hotel in your garden.
