Please look at Home Learning Grid for more detail on today's activities.

<u>English focus</u>: Being thankful as we end our school year. Can you make a list of words to help describe who you are thankful for? Over the next two days we shall be making cards for our dinner staff, caretakers TAs etc and writing messages inside as to why we are thankful for them. At home, perhaps you are thankful to grandma or mummy, daddy or your big brother or sister and you could make them a card or write them a letter.

<u>English key questions:</u> Why is it important to say thank you? How does it feel when somebody says thank you to you?

<u>Phonics focus:</u> revisit all sounds learnt this term, focussing on those which may need extra practice. Use games on phonics play or some of the other practical games and activities we sent out earlier this term.

<u>Maths focus</u>: Please see the problem in the document sent out called 'Maths Activity sheets w/b 13.7.2020' and try the Coloured Square Investigation. You could use squares of coloured paper or cubes to support the recording of this investigation.

Maths key questions: Where will you start? What are the rules? What strategies did you have?

Now choose one other challenge from the home learning grid.
