Breakfast and After School Club in St James' Primary School

SJOut offers before and after school care for children in St James' Primary School. Children are collected either straight from school or from whichever after school activity they may be participating in.

Breakfast club from 7.30 till 8.45am Monday till Friday
£8.50 (for permanent place)/ £9.00 (for ad-hoc booking). Breakfast is included.

After school club from 3.00 till 6.15pm Monday till Friday
£6.50 (for permanent place)/ £7.00 (for ad-hoc booking) per hour and £2.00 per snack. Snacks are included in each on-line booking time slot.

Our primary aim is to offer a flexible service designed around what the parents and children want, with a real focus on health and outdoor activity!

Children are encouraged to initiate and lead their own play with their friends and be guided by the staff to ensure levels of participation and inclusion. They are free to choose activities and resources as they wish. There is always a wide selection of activities and resources available, including toys, arts and crafts, board games, construction, sports and games, dressing up and reading.

We have a flexible online booking system, so you can use us as you wish. Whether that's just one day per week, a couple of days per term or just ad-hoc when you need, booking with just a days notice i.e. the day before, subject to availability.
