**English focus:** Write about what happened when you tried your boat again after making some improvements. Can you say why you think it sank or floated? Don't forget to write down how many blocks (or what you used as cargo) it held. Can you say what you would use if you tried your experiment again? Can you share any facts you have learnt about boats?

**English key questions:** Why did your boat sink or float? Was it better or worse than the first boat? What have you learnt about boats and what they need to work well?

**Phonics focus:** Revise alternative pronunciations for a, y, ch, ou

**Maths focus**: Problem solving — explore the four problems below through discussion and recording some examples. Are the following statements about number always true, sometimes true or never true?

How do you know?

When you add two numbers you can change the order and the answer will be the same	If you add 10 and take away 1 it is the same as adding 9
When you add 10 to a number the answer is a multiple of 10	When you subtract one number from another number you can change the order and the answer will be the same.
