Hope you are all enjoying the weather!

Here are the challenges for today:

Phonics: Today you will be looking at the sounds ow and oi. (Ow as in 'now', oi as in 'coin') Can you look in a book and see how many times you can spot these sounds? Can you try and read the word? Can you think of any other words with these sounds in? Can you make up a story using these words: cow, brown, frown, coin, point, soil?

You may want to look on Cbeebies and watch some Alphablocks shows

We also have a tricky word of the day – 'happy'. What things make you happy? Can you make up a sentence with this word in? What about a silly sentence? Can you write a sentence?

Maths: Go on a number search around your house, (on clocks, food tins ect) What numbers can you find? Can you do that many jumps? (hops, skips, claps, bunny jumps) Which is the biggest/smallest number? Can you put them in order? How many of the same number can you find?

Daily Challenge: Can you design an Easter egg? What could you use? Paper, playdough, plasticine or a real egg? Can you hide it around your house for someone to find?
