Dear Year 1,

Please look at Home Learning Grid and the Phonics Sheet for more detail on today's activities.

English focus: Boat design and labels

English key questions: Can you design your own boat that you are going to build. Make sure you try the science activity first so that you will have an idea of the best materials to use for your boat. Label your picture with the junk materials and other things you are going to use. **Can you explain why you chose those materials? e.g 'I chose plastic because it is waterproof'**

Phonics focus: Looking at alternative pronunciations **y** (yes, by, gym, very)

Maths focus: Capacity – ordering amounts using capacity and language of comparing.

Maths key questions: Choose 4 (**or more**) containers of similar sizes. Can you work out which holds the most?

Give the children 4 empty containers – try to make them different shapes. Let the children experiment first to see their ideas. You can use water, sand or pasta/rice for this. If they need some help fill one container and pour it in to another. If it overflows it holds less and if it holds all of it, it holds more.

Then choose one other activity from the Home Learning Grid.
