



Dear Year 1,

Please look at the Home Learning Grid or the Phonics Sheet for more detail on today's activities.

English focus: The first activity focuses on speaking and listening. The children will be talking about their boats and discussing what happened when they tested it. They will then write a sentence or two about what happened e.g. It floated/sunk because... Remember when writing to use a capital letter, finger spaces and end with a full stop.

English key questions: Build your boat and test it out on some water. Does it sink or float? It floated/sunk because... Which materials worked well? What would you change if you made it again?

Phonics focus: Looking at alternative pronunciations **ch** (chin, school, chef, Charlotte)

Maths focus: Capacity
