Over the Easter break we challenge you to

- Create a rainbow positivity book
- or
- Create a family board game about Easter or your class animal
- or
- Plant a vegetable seed and take photos of it at each stage.

Create a rainbow positivity book

The idea is that it is a resource that makes you feel positive.

You can use paper, card, a scrapbook or do it digitally.

Include pictures and paintings, colouring pages, poems, quotations, patterns and photos of fun things that you have done with your family – anything that brings you HAPPINESS!

My book is going to have pictures and photos of fun things I have done with my family, and lots more. I have already started gathering some ideas like this sunset of hope.



Create a family board game about Easter or your class animal

Step 1. Play a variety of board games with your family.

What makes them exciting? Do they have rules? How do you know how to play the game? Talk about this with an adult.

Step 2. Decide whether your board game is going to be about Easter or your class animal. (You may need to do a little research about your chosen theme).

Step 3. You will need to decide how the game is played. Don't make it too complicated.

Step 4. Design and make the board. How could you decorate the board to make it appealing?

Step 5. Name your game.

Step 6. Finalise the rules.

Step 7. Include instructions of how to play the game.

Step 8. Include resources – counters, dice etc.

Extension – Make a box for the game.

Can your family give some feedback on your game?

What was good?

What did they like about?

Did they enjoy playing it?

Plant a vegetable seed – Take pictures of it and each different stage of growth.

We ask that you share this creative home learning with us after Easter on Thursday 16th or Friday 17th April.
