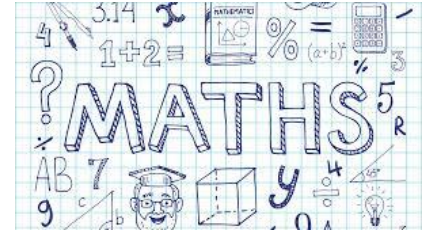


Welcome to a wonderful Wednesday

Edit and improve your first chapter as necessary – make sure you have had it checked by your teacher in case he/she needs you to make any changes.

Write sentences to go with your Week 6 list of words (and Week 5) if not yet done.

For those of you who have already edited and finished your story, an **optional** task is to write a poem describing life at sea. You could start at the port (smells, sounds, sight) and contrast it out in the middle of the ocean/sea, miles from land (sound, smells, sights).

Kensuke's Kingdom Chapter 2 will have given you some ideas.



Science:

Another **optional** task which might have been set/alluded to yesterday is to devise your own origami boat related question to test. Remember a question starts with **the part you will change** and ends with **how you will measure changes**. Eg: How does the **type/size of paper** affect its **ability to float**?

Write your question and prediction then test it out. Record your results (what happened). Reread your question then write a paragraph to conclude your investigation.
