Good Morning. We hope you have had a lovely weekend.

This week we will continue to focus on the story of 'A Home on the River.'

Maths

This week we will be revising addition and subtraction.

Don't say 20.

A game for 2 players.

Start at 1

The first person to take a turn chooses the number 1, 2 or 3.



The next player chooses to continue the count with 1,2 or 3 numbers.

For example, if the 1st player chooses 2, the 2nd player counts 3, or 3,4 or 3,4,5.

Continue to take turns. The aim is to avoid saying 20.

(A number track/ ten frame could be used to make this more visual)

Phonics

Play the game: Buried Treasure

Practise reading words with all the sounds we have learnt.

Have a mixture of real and made up words and sort them out as you read.



Daily Challenge



Remind yourself of the story 'A Home on the River.'

Have a go at naming the animals in the story. Can you remember them all?

How could you sort them?
