Topic: Knowing Me, Knowing You		
<p>Next week's learning:</p> <p>Maths: We will learn about the addition symbol and focus on the rule of commutativity e.g. $2+3=5$, $3+2=5$, $5=2+3$ and $5=3+2$. We will systematically find pairs of numbers that make 10 and begin to practise recalling these quickly.</p> <p>English: We will begin to focus on traditional tales. We will be looking at 'The Enormous Turnip' to begin with to link to our recent work on Harvest. We will particularly focus on the characters and construct sentences focusing on the 'Who' within a sentence.</p> <p>Wider curriculum: We will continue to celebrate Black History Month. We will be thinking about how we can record information in Science in prepared tables and graphs. In Music, we have enjoyed listening to different songs and pieces of music and thinking about how it makes us feel, we will continue to do this.</p> <p>Additional Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be thinking about our favourite stories.
