English focus: Can you put the words into alphabetical order? We have attached some activities to try at the end of the plan. You could also see if you could write a word for every letter of the alphabet. Maybe a list of foods, or names or even just your favourite things. You do not need to do all of them, choose the ones you would like to do. You could even hide letters of the alphabet in a picture, or make your own alphabet book with a collage of pictures beginning with that letter.

## **English key questions:**

Can you sing the alphabet? Can you say the alphabet? Can you write the alphabet?

## **Phonics focus:** Revision of all sounds learnt this term.

There is no separate phonics plan this week. Use phonics play or some of the practical ideas and games from earlier on in the term to recap the sounds we have learnt.

## Maths focus:

Please feel free to pick either the Mr Toad treasure map activity or one of the Maths coordinate activities; you don't need to do them all today. If you have any old maps around maybe you can have a look and try to find some places on that.

Please remind your child(ren) that to give coordinates we go along the corridor (give the horizontal coordinate on the x-axis first) then up the stairs (give the vertical coordinate on the y-axis second). Coordinates are also separated by a comma and have brackets around them.

## Maths key questions:

Which coordinate do we start with? How do we write coordinates?

Then choose one other activity from the Home Learning Grid.
