

Year 1 Phonics Week Beginning 18th May 2020

Please look on the phonicsplay website for the games suggested. There are lots of great resources you can use.

Suggested activities/words:

- ☺ Try to do flashcards/speed trial on phonics play 2-3 times per week.
- ☺ Can you make a list of words that rhyme using the sound of the day?
- ☺ Can you write the sound? Think about where to start the letter. You could use chalks, glitter, make it out of playdoh, write it in flour, use magnetic letters.
- ☺ Can you write some different words with this sound in?
- ☺ Write the words in chalk on the wall outside. Use a water pistol or nerf gun to fire at the correct word!
- ☺ Play a game of "snap" or "pairs" with the sounds you have learnt so far. You could also match the sound with a word or a picture with the sound in. e.g. u_e and a picture of a cube. Twinkl have some pictures of each sound. Just type the sound into the search bar. (for alternative pronunciation letters type alternative g for example)
- ☺ Can you say some sentences to your grown up using the example words? Make them sensible or silly!
- ☺ Have a look at www.ictgames.co.uk and look at the English games on there.
- ☺ Have a go at reading the sentences 5b for each sound we've practiced this week

Monday: Sound of the day: a we are looking at alternative pronunciations

Example Words: hat, splash, band, laptop, grand, bacon, apron, angel, apricot, bagel, fast, bath, grass, after, path, was, what, squad, want, wander.

Can you play Acorn Adventures using the alternative **a** sound on phonics play, phase 5b games?

Tuesday: Sound of the day: y we are looking at alternative pronunciations

Example Words: yes, yell, yawn, yellow, yet, by, why, dry, reply, sky, gym, crystal, pyramid, myth, happy, funny, hairy, smelly, crunchy

Can you play Cheeky Chimps using the alternative **y** sound on phonics play, phase 5b games?

Wednesday: ch we are looking at alternative pronunciations

Example Words: church, chick, crunch, pinch, chirping, school, chemist, chord, chorus, technical, chef, chalet, brochure, machine

Can you play Acorn Adventures using the alternative **ch** sound on phonics play, phase 5b games?

Thursday: ou we are looking at alternative pronunciations

Example Words: loud, proud, sound, round, mountain, you, soup, group, could, would, should, mould, shoulder, boulder.

Can you play either Cheeky Chimps using the alternative **ou** sound on phonics play, phase 5b games?

Friday: Sound of the day: please revise all the sounds we have been learning this term.

Split digraphs: a_e, e_e, i_e, o_e, u_e

Alternative pronunciation of: i, o, c, g, u, ow, ie, ea, er, ay, y, ch, ou,

You may also like to include ey (money, they) as an alternative pronunciation which is in the games but not the planning.
