Please see the 'Tuesday' column on your home learning grid or today's Maths and English learning. Here are some reminders and tips to help you:

English

Choose a type of transport (it can be the Jolly Postman's bicycle or any other you are interested in). You are going to make a poster about it.

1. Make sure you write the name of the transport in clear writing at the top.
2. Draw a picture of this transport and label the different parts.
3. Then, use the internet (or books if you have some that can help) to find out about it. Think of some interesting questions to help you decide what to research.

For example, if I chose a train, I would want to find out:

- When was the first train invented? Who invented it?
- Where has the longest trainline? Is there a longest ever train?
- What was the first train journey? Where did it start and end?

4. Add any facts you find to your poster!

If you would like an extra challenge, write an account of how the vehicle works.

Maths

How many number sentences can you think of, where the answer is 15? Remember to try and use all 4 number operations (+ - x ÷). You can then challenge yourself further, by thinking of word problems (little stories), where the answer is 15.

For example:

- The hen laid 5 eggs Monday, 8 eggs Tuesday and 2 eggs Wednesday. She laid 15 altogether.
- There were 25 light bulbs. 10 broke. Now only 15 light bulbs are on.

Reading

Read one of the books you bought home from school, or one of your own. Answer some questions to show your understanding. Remember, can you find evidence in the text (where does it say it? What word/phrase tells you that?) to support your answers.

Please then select a couple of the '**Topic**' activities to complete this afternoon.
